Option 1 – Introduction to Archery

Cost: \$25.00

This class is intended for the new archer. The student will learn:

- Archery safety
- Basic care and maintenance for equipment
- Basic archery form and technique

This 1 session, 1 hour class is limited to 5 students.

Option 2 – Archery Skills Development

Cost: \$160.00

This class is intended for the new or novice archer who is interested in becoming proficient at recreational, competitive and/or hunting archery. The student will learn:

- Archery safety
- Care and maintenance for equipment
- Basic equipment tuning
- Skills and methods to develop correct and consistent archery form and technique

This class includes 8 – 1 hour sessions and is limited to 5 students.

Option 3 - Basic Archery Instructor Training and Certification

Cost: \$75.00

This class is intended for individuals wishing to become certified by the National Association for the Development of Archery as a USA-Archery/NFAA basic archery instructor. This training is required by most camps and organizations for individuals involved in conducting archery programs (ACA, BSA, Girl Scouts, 4H, etc.).

The class includes 1 session lasting from 8 to 10 hours depending on the number of participants. The class is limited to 3-12 participants.

Option 4 – Bowhunter Education (SC Dept. of Natural Resources and IBEF Certification)

Cost: FREE

This class is intended for bowhunters of all skill levels who wish to develop or improve their understanding and knowledge of conservation, woodsmanship and ethics associated with bowhunting. This class also serves to satisfy the certification requirements for U.S. states and Canadian provinces requiring Bowhunter education for non-resident hunters

FOR ALL CLASSES, THE STUDENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING THEIR OWN EQUIPMENT. EQUIPMENT MUST BE IN SAFE WORKING CONDITION AND MUST INCLUDE FOREARM AND FINGER PROTECTION.
